The successful candidate will have an opportunity to work in a fast changing and dynamic growth market. This role will work across departments and touch transactions in the seed, grain, supply chain and sales space.

Key Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with the grower relationship management team regarding grower contracts and accurately enter contract data into SAP. Create contract management reporting to support the grower relationship and supply chain teams.
- Work with logistics team regarding the shipment, transportation, contract application and material transfer from growers to Calyxt managed grain elevators and then to contracted crushers. Trouble shoot with carriers as needed.
- Coordinate with logistics team to arrange a local warehouse delivery plan.
- Work directly with our sales team to enter customer orders and contracts into SAP and perform contract management tasks regarding movement of Finished

Goods and Co- Products. Create contract management reporting to support the sales and supply chain teams.

- Develop and document processes from grain origination through finished good delivery to customers.
- Follow up electronically with carriers and customers to confirm successful delivery.
- Ensure timely execution and regular follow-up with all related counterparties including grain elevators, crushers, carriers and customers.
- Work closely with the accounting group at month-end to reconcile all transactions.
